Roles	Tasks
<p>Editor-in-chief</p> 	Edits material for final print, aids in running class meetings, and facilitates communication among staff members.
<p>Section Editors</p> 	Edits for grammar, mechanics, and then submits the articles to be copyedited and reviewed by Professor Dickey and the Editor-in-Chief.
<p>Photographer</p> 	Receives photo requests from writers/editors, takes staff photos for articles, and takes photos for each article that requires them.
<p>Layout & Design</p> 	Place the articles in appropriate formats, Fit in photos and other material so that columns fit together nicely.
<p>Writer</p> 	All writers must MEET DEADLINES, write a rough draft (700 or more words), attend group meetings, edit their article, submit articles to Google Doc, and submit two new/unique ideas for the following issue.
